Nadia Kaabi-Linke was born in 1978 in Tunis to an Ukrainian mother and Tunisian father. She studied at the University of Fine Arts in Tunis (1999) before receiving a PhD from the Sorbonne University in Paris (2008). Her installations, objects and pictorial works are embedded in urban contexts, intertwined with memory and geographically and politically constructed identities. Her last solo exhibitions were "Stranded" (2014) in Lisbon, Portugal, "No One Harms Me"(2013) in Kolkata, India, "Black is the New White"(2012) in Dubai, UAE, and "Tatort/Crime Scene" (2010) in Berlin, Germany. She has participated in group exhibitions at The Museum of Modern Art, New York, USA, the Nam June Paik Art Center at Seoul, Korea (2013); the Liverpool Biennial, UK; Herbert F Johnson Museum, Ithaca, NY, USA (2012); and 54th Venice Biennial in Italy (2011).
